As a local author, I have given talks at library functions such as “Lunch and Learn” and meet the author events, at various civic clubs, and as a panelist at LibertyCon and SciFi Summer Con. My debut novel, **The Gift Horse**, is a contemporary suspense story about Angela Donelson, a teenager from a small town in Georgia who becomes the victim in a bizarre kidnapping plot. While classified as science fiction, this book has been reviewed by sites which focus on romance, due to its emphasis on relationships rather than hardware. **Trinity on Tylos** has garnered several positive reviews including a “recommended read” designation from *Fallen Angels Reviews*.

I currently serve as an adjunct instructor of English at a local post-secondary institution. I taught middle and high school English for twenty years, and I have degrees in English from Piedmont College and North Georgia College. While teaching at Jefferson High School, I was the advisor for twelve yearbooks, so I have knowledge about printing and publishing as well as literature. I’ve made talks in a variety of situations.

My love of books, writing, and storytelling is genuine, and I appreciate any opportunity to share it with readers and those who have an interest in being published themselves one day.
