Pamela J. Dodd has published two novels, **Trinity on Tylos**, a science fiction thriller (February 2006 ), and **The Gift Horse**, a contemporary suspense tale (February 2004). *Living Jackson* magazine reviewed **The Gift Horse** in June of 2006 and numerous online sites have reviewed **Trinity on Tylos**. Although she often does speaking engagements to promote her writing, Pamela is also adept at technology and has been a guest at reader's groups via the internet, hosts a blog on writing, and does her own web design.

As a speaker, Pamela brings warmth, humor, and a genuine love of reading and writing to her audiences. Pamela currently serves as an adjunct instructor at a local technical college and is accustomed to modifying her material for a variety of people. Her audiences have ranged in number from fewer than ten to two hundred plus, and ages from eight to eighty plus years. Drawing on anecdotes from her life experiences, Pamela often manages to bring a smile to the faces of her listeners.
